Empowering teachers to serve as experts solves three nagging problems with school and district reliance on external trainers:

- External trainers can’t be everywhere at once.
- Trainees become passive, diluting their impetus to find and develop solutions.
- When external trainers move on, follow-up guidance does too and implementation stalls.

“A lot of teachers already provide technology leadership, either because they’re interested by nature, or because they help their colleagues on an informal basis,” said Dixon, director of strategic relationships and 22-year teaching and administrative veteran. “How many of us have ‘gone next door’ with tech issues because we know a teacher there who can help?”
